


### Q3 What is your marital status?

# Q4 If you have children living in your household, HOW MANY fall in each of these age groups?









### Q6 What is the highest level of education you have completed?



### Q7 How long does it generally take you to travel from home to church?







# Q13 How would you describe your knowledge of Presbyterian Reformed theology?



### Q14 How would you describe your knowledge of the Bible?







## Q17 About how often did you attend Sunday worship services during 2022?





# Q18 If your active participation has DECREASED over the last three years, what are the reasons for that? (Select all that apply.)






# Q19 If your active participation has INCREASED over the last three years, what are the reasons for that? (Select all that apply.)



# Q20 How important is EACH of the listed elements in determining a compelling WORSHIP SERVICE?












## Q37 Do you expect to be an active participant in the life of WPC five years from now?




